**WELCOME TO FORT LAUDERDALE
BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CENTER!**

While we know the importance of family-centered care, the visitation times have been selected to not interfere with your loved one's therapeutic schedule, as they need to be able to obtain the maximum benefit in their treatment.

- Currently we are limiting the space to only 10 slots – sign up will be on a first come, first serve basis.
- For proper processing for safety, you are required to arrive 30 minutes prior to the start of visitation in the Patient Lobby on the south end of the facility.
- Only two ADULT visitors per patient. We will not switch out visitors. Only parents/guardians are allowed.
- All visitors will be wanded and searched.
- Personal items are not permitted in the hospital. We will not be able to secure items within the facility.
- All visitors must be 18 years and older (children cannot be left in the lobby unattended).
- Items brought to patients must be limited to one bag and will be searched and delivered within 24 hours.
- Food items will not be permissible.
